



Announcement Benelux-Cup Nijmegen

Nijmeegse Schaatsvereniging (NSV) in cooperation with the Koninklijke Nederlandsche Schaatsenrijders Bond (KNSB) cordially invites you for the Benelux-cup competition of the season 2021-2022 at the Triavium IJsbahn en Evenementen Van Rosenbergweg 2, 6537 TM Nijmegen

Provisional Program:

Skater registration: 7.30h – 8.00h

Warming-up: 8.15h – 8.45h

Start of competition: 9.00h

End of competition: 14.00h

Notice: The final program will be published on www.ShorttrackOnline.info a few days before the start of the competition. Be sure to check this in advance.

Distances: The distances will be determined based on the number of skaters and the available time. The races will be run according to the all-final system. Each rider qualifies for the next round.

Intended distances:

Kids on ice, Juniors F 222m, 333m

Junior E-D-C-B-A-senior/masters 500m, 777m/1000m, depending on division.

If time permits a super final or relay can be added.

Entry: Through the relevant club's competition secretary via

Closing entry: Tuesday March 1, 2022

Division: "Kids on Ice" – normal skaters with little or no previous competition experience and Junior F.

"Other skaters" – all other skaters with a Belgian, Dutch or Luxembourg License.

Dutch skaters must belong to a club from the Region NBLZ.

The organization reserves the right to change the composition of the divisions in the interest of safety and / or a good competition.

Category:

Junior F: op 1-7-2021: 8 jaar or younger

Junior E: op 1-7-2021: 9 or 10 years old

Junior D: op 1-7-2021: 11 or 12 years old
Junior C: op 1-7-2021: 13 or 14 years old
Junior B: op 1-7-2021: 15 or 16 years old
Junior A: op 1-7-2021: 17 or 18 years old
Senioren/masters: op 1-7-2021: 19, 19 plus.

Helmet caps: All skaters need to have helmet caps. The caps will be handed out before the competition. After the competition the caps need to be returned. An amount of € 20,00 will be charged to the skater for each unreturned helmet cap.

Registration fee: An invoice with the registration fee of € 15,00 per skater will be sent to the clubs.

Safety: The KNSB has issued Safety Regulations applicable to all competitions in The Netherlands. These regulations will be applicable to all participating skaters in Category C and above.

Skaters in Category D-E-F and “Kids on ice” should comply with ISU Communication 1265 and 2400 and applicable rules such as Rule 291. (Helmet, shin and knee protection, cut-resistant gloves, cut-resistant neck protection obligated and eye protection recommended)
