## Distances:

The distances will be determined based on the number of skaters. It is the intention to organise a relay in the categories Jun DEF and ABC Senior/Masters.

## Entry:

Through the relevant club's competition secretary via <a href="www.shorttrackonline.info">www.shorttrackonline.info</a>

Closing entry: Sunday 7th December, 2025

In case the event has an unmanageable number of entries the Organisers will follow the rule: first come first served

## Start procedure:

For all categories, there will be a tolerance of one false start.

## Participants:

- Skaters with a Belgian, Dutch or Luxembourg License
- Dutch skaters must be member of a club from Region NBLZ ("Gewest Noord-Brabant / Limburg / Zeeland").
- Participation of skaters from outside the region
  - 1. Participation of skaters from other Dutch regions is only possible if skaters are not allowed to participate in their own region, due to their regulations. This will only be possible for skaters in age category Jun ABC or Senior/Master.
  - 2. Participation of skaters from other countries is possible for skaters in age category Jun ABC or Senior/Master. These skaters should be entered by their club secretariat on the waiting list on https://shorttrackonline.info/entry.php
  - 3. Registration for participating for skaters from outside the region

Skaters can be registered by their club secretariat on the waiting list. After closing of the entry, the organizing committee and Competitor Steward will decide how many and which skaters will be let in to the competition. Organizing committee will inform the club secretariat of the skaters at the latest Monday prior to the competition.

If more places become available later in the week, other skaters from the waiting list can be contacted (via their club secretariat) to join the competition.

## Category:

Junior F - born after 30/06/2016

Junior E - born between 01/07/2014 and 30/06/2016

Junior D - born between 01/07/2012 and 30/06/2014

Junior C - born between 01/07/2010 and 30/06/2012

Junior B - born between 01/07/2008 and 30/06/2010

Junior A - born between 01/07/2006 and 30/06/2008

Senior & Master born before 30/06/2006

The organisers reserve the right to compose the divisions in the interest of safety and/or a good competition.

## Award:

EF: all participants will be awarded with a medal.

Individual classification DEF & ABCS: awards will be given to the first, second and third in the final classification of each category.

#### Helmet caps:

All skaters need to have helmet caps.

The caps will be handed out to the team leader/coach.

A fee of €10 in CASH will be asked for each cap with a maximum of €50 per club.

We kindly ask you to bring the exact amount in an envelope with the club name and the amount in it.

At the end of the competition the fee will be given back when the caps are returned.

If the rider needs stickers instead of a cap because of the use of a skate-Tec 025 Visor they must indicate this immediately upon registration. These stickers will cost €2,-.

## Registration fee:

An entry fee of €30 per skater must be paid to the organiser.

To reduce the amount of cash and fast handling, we ask you to wire the money by bank transfer to the organiser's bank account no later than **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> December**, **2025**.

Use the following format message with the transfer: "Benelux Club X", with the abbreviation of your club on ShorttrackOnline, and X the number of skaters you are paying for. This number should correspond to the number of entered skaters on ShorttrackOnline.

For example: Benelux NSV 5.

Clubs can only make the entries with the approval of their respective ISU member at: shorttrackonline.info.

### **Track Conditions:**

The track is an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface with the measures of 30 \* 60 meters. The protective padding is in accordance with ISU Communication No 2365. The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap with measured curves of 8 meters and there will be 7 markers used to establish the curve. The length of the straight is 28.85 meters. Beside the original track there will be 4 tracks set up to preserve good ice conditions. For all tracks one finish line will be used.

#### Safety:

The KNSB have issued Safety Regulations application to all competitions in the Netherlands. These regulations will be applicable to all participating skaters in Category C and above.

Skaters in category D-E-F and "Kids on ice" should comply with ISU Communication 1265 (helmet, shin and knee protection, cut-free gloves and neck protection) and applicable Rules such as Rule 291
