The event will run from 09:00 to 14:00.

Provisional schedule: The final time schedule will be announced later.

- Rider check-in starts: 08:00
- Check-in closes: 08:30
- Warm-up: 08:30
- Competition starts: 09:00
- Competition ends: 14:00

Distances:

Distances will be announced later and will depend on available time and number of participants.

Participation in the Benelux-Cup:

Participation is according to KNSB rules:

All skaters registered by a club in Belgium, the Dutch region “Gewest Noord-Brabant / Limburg / Zeeland” or Luxembourg are allowed to participate in the Benelux-Cup. Participating skaters must have a valid competition license from their own federation in order to compete in the Benelux-Cup.

Participation of skaters from outside the region:

1. Participation of skaters from Dutch regions is only possible if skaters are not allowed to participate in their own region, due to their regulations. This will only be possible for skaters in age category Jun ABC or Senior/Master.
2. Participation of skaters from other countries is possible for skaters in age category Jun ABC or Senior/Master.

These skaters (1 or 2) should be entered by their club secretariat on the waiting list on <https://shorttrackonline.info/entry.php>

Registration for participating for skaters from outside the region

Skaters can be registered by their club secretariat on the waiting list. After closing of the entry, the organizing committee and Competitor Steward will decide how many and which skaters will be let in to the competition. Organizing committee will inform the club secretariat of the skaters at the latest Monday prior to the competition. If more places become available later in the week, other skaters from the waiting list can be contacted (via their club secretariat) to join the competition.

Division:

In the program / composition of divisions, the organizing committee will take into account the latest developments regarding the Starclass limits, as well as the participation of skaters with less experience. The organizers reserve the right to change the composition of the divisions in the interest of safety and / or a good competition.

Start procedure:

For all categories there will be a tolerance of one false start.

Category:

Junior F: born after 30/06/2016
Junior E: born from 1/07/2014 to 30/06/2016
Junior D: born from 1/07/2012 to 30/06/2014
Junior C: born from 1/07/2010 to 30/06/2012
Junior B: born from 1/07/2008 to 30/06/2010
Junior A: born from 1/07/2006 to 30/06/2008
Senior & Masters: born before 30/06/2006

Awards:

EF: all participants will be awarded with a medal. Individual classification
DEF & ABCS: awards will be given to the first, second and third in the final classification of each category.

Helmet Caps:

Helmet caps are mandatory in the Benelux Cup competition. Caps will be provided for each race and must be returned afterward. A fee of €20 will be charged for any unreturned cap. For skaters with a Skate-Tec helmet with visor (where caps do not fit), stickers with helmet numbers are available at €2 per set of two numbers. Clubs must indicate in the registration comments which skaters require sticker numbers.

Entry Fee:

The entry fee is €25 per participant. After registration closes, the club will receive a list of registered participants along with a payment request to the organization's bank account. Payment must be made within 2 days of receipt.

Safety:

The KNSB has established safety rules for all competitions held in the Netherlands. These rules apply to all skaters and can be found here:
